Review of March Financials

- Crosspointe is on-track with its revenues.
- Landmark owes us a refund.

Landscaping

- As a result of ongoing issues with Landmark, we are terminating their contract.
- Blue Grass Landscapes will provide emergency lawn maintenance services on 4/18.
- The Board is currently reviewing vendor proposals for a new contract.

<u>Trees</u>

- Clarence will be in the community to trim five trees needing extra trimming to keep limbs away from our units.
- Sally and JoAnn will complete their list of trees in the community in need of cutting back. Clarence will use this list to give us an estimate for doing so.
- Sally was able to get the assessment list from Heartwood, the company that did the initial spreadsheet assessment and identification of problematic trees within our community several years ago.
- Sally is putting together a small group of Crosspointe residents to serve on a committee focused on identifying, analyzing, and recommending solutions to the issues we have with trees/tree roots within Crosspointe.

Street Leaks

• Larry is meeting with a civil engineer to review what we've done to address our ongoing issues with street leaks and discuss a path forward.

Fire Pits

- Larry spoke with several companies and officials from surrounding fire departments about requirements for fire pits and developed draft policy guidelines based on his research.
- Sally is working on putting the draft into a resolution to be added to Crosspointe's Rules and Regulations.
